The contents of the HIP field

Name of field of HIP: psychology

The content of the HIP field psychology is focused on the investigation, interpretation, influence and prognostic evaluation of the behaviour and experiencing of a person or a group of people using psychological methods, techniques and procedures corresponding to the current knowledge of the psychological sciences and the state of economic and social practice mainly in the areas of organizational and work psychology, clinical and counselling psychology, of pedagogical and school psychology. The HIP field includes knowledge from various psychological areas, as well as the basics of other non-psychological disciplines that are related to psychology, especially philosophy, anthropology, human biology and pedagogy. The HIP field emphasizes knowledge in basic specializations, in the main theories and techniques used in psychological assessment and psychological intervention.



Definition of the HIP field

The content of the HIP field is in accordance with the focus of the Psychology study department, to which it belongs assigned to. The content of the field is defined in such a way that it corresponds to the main topics and core knowledge in the field of Psychology.

The main content elements of the HP and IP field are, in particular:

- Knowledge of all theoretical (basic and special disciplines) and selected applied psychological disciplines, which are mostly oriented towards the individual, or towards the psychological aspects of his behaviour and experiencing within groups.
- Knowledge of the development of psychology as a science, general, developmental, educational, school, social, clinical, counseling psychology, personality psychology and psychopathology.
- Knowledge of the basics of psychological assessment, psychometrics, methodology and data analysis
